Embroidery Hoop Display & Fabric Backing Instructions

Your embroidery is finished and looking beautiful!

Create a backing panel: Place the inner hoop on top of the plain piece of fabric and draw a circle around the outside edge. Cut your circle out. Place to one side for a moment.

Display placement: Take your finished embroidered panel and secure it in your hoop. Trim the excess fabric so that 1.5-2cm is left.



Use a running stitch to stitch around this excess fabric. Pull the thread tight drawing it in.

Tie a knot to secure in place. Tip: use double (or more) yarns, and/or run another row of stitches to help keep it secure.

You can leave your hoop like this (as the back will normally be hidden) or continue to add the backing panel.

Attatch backing panel: Now, place your extra panel on top of the back. Stitch in place. Use a simple running stitch or a decorative blanket stitch.



Use the ribbon to create a decorative bow and/or a hanging loop.
