# Tea Cosy

### Pattern & Instructions





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Pattern Piece Instructions

#### You will need:

Printer \*Print at 100% on A4
Your finished embroidered panel
Back Panel fabric (30x42cm/12x16In)
\*30x50cm/12x20In inc. in main kit
Lining Fabric (60x42cm/24x16In)
Wadding (60x42cm/24x16In)
Bias Binding (6x120cm)
Sewing needle, Sewing thread
Sewing machine (optional)

#### **Instructions**

Note: All Seam Allowances are 1.5cm / 0.59Inches. The fabrics do not have a right/wrong side, "right and wrong side" are used for construction purposes. You can stitch by hand or machine.



I. Cut out your embroidered & plain back panel. Cut your bias binding (6cm/2.36 inches wide) - create a hanging loop by folding the bias binding in half (lengthways) stitch (lengthways) with a I-I.5cm SA - approx IOCM long and pull rightside out - press flat.

Place these right sides together (place your top loop and label in the seam between these 2 panels) stitch together. Press the seam open, and turn right side out.






2. Cut your I pair of lining, Place the lining panels right sides together and stitch, then press the seams open and keep as wrong side out.



3. Cut I pair of wadding. Place the edge of each wadding next to each other and zig zag stitch.



- 4. Place the stitched wadding inside the embroidered layer, place the lining inside the wadding layer. optional: pin the sides and centres together at the open base.
- 5. Attach the bias binding to the right side of the embroidered layer along the raw hem edge. Stitch in place 1.5cm up from the raw edge.
- 6. Fold down and press, then turn to the inside and fold again. Hand stitch the folded edge to the lining.
